2026 Shotgun - Group & Tournament Pricing

All pricing includes green fee, power cart, \$25 food and beverage card, \$25 Golf Shop credit and a \$5 golf service gratuity.

A shotgun start is a golf tournament format where all players of a tournament are split into groups of four. Each foursome starts at a different hole, and all groups tee off simultaneously from their respective tee boxes. Once the round is underway, the groups play a full 18-holes and finish at the hole which they started. The advantage of a shotgun start is that all golfers complete their round at approximately the same time.

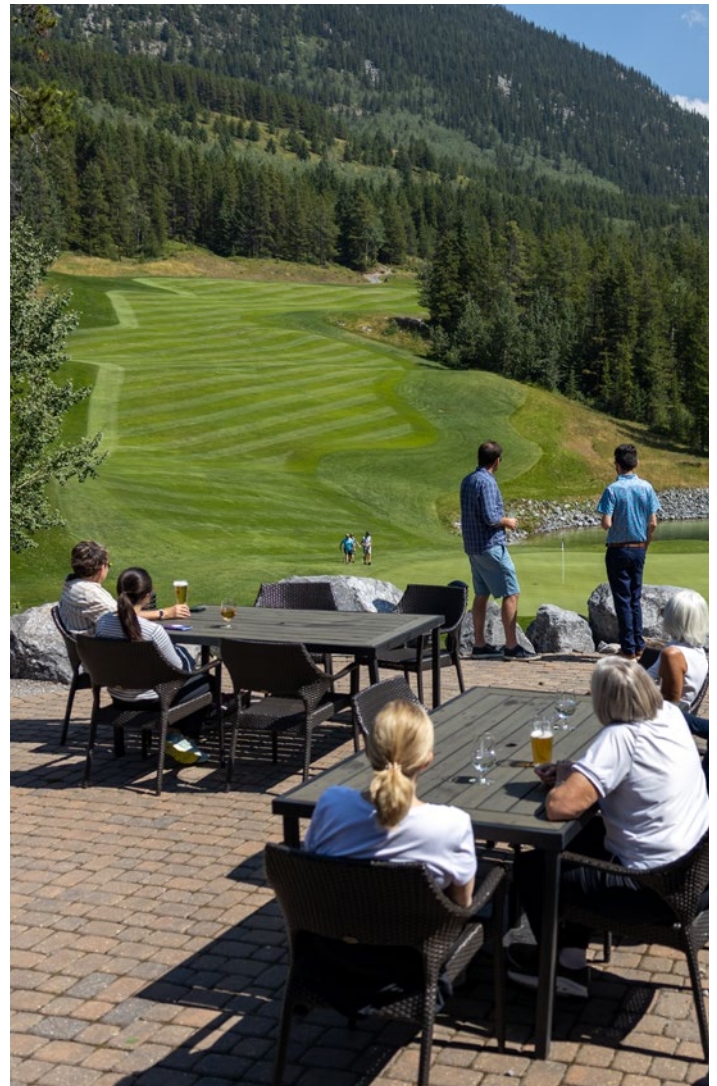

Popular Tournament Formats

In selecting a playing format for your golf event, your Event Manager will ensure you choose the perfect fit for your tournament's guests. Our goal is to ensure that the format you select promotes enjoyment and fairness for all participants, regardless of their golfing ability.

Scramble

SKILL LEVEL: **ENTRY** | GAME LENGTH: **5 TO 6 HOURS** | PLAYERS: **2-4**

The scramble is one of the primary forms of tournament play for golf associations and charity events.

A scramble is usually played with 4-person teams, but 2-person scrambles are popular, too. At a 2-person scramble, handicaps are often applied; at a 4-person scramble, handicaps are not applied.

In a scramble, each player tees off on each hole. The best of the tee shots is selected and all players play their second shots from that spot. The best of the second shots is determined, then all play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed.

Shamble

SKILL LEVEL: **INTERMEDIATE** | GAME LENGTH: **5 TO 6 HOURS** | PLAYERS: **2-4**

A shamble is a type of golf tournament that combines elements of a scramble with elements of regular stroke play.

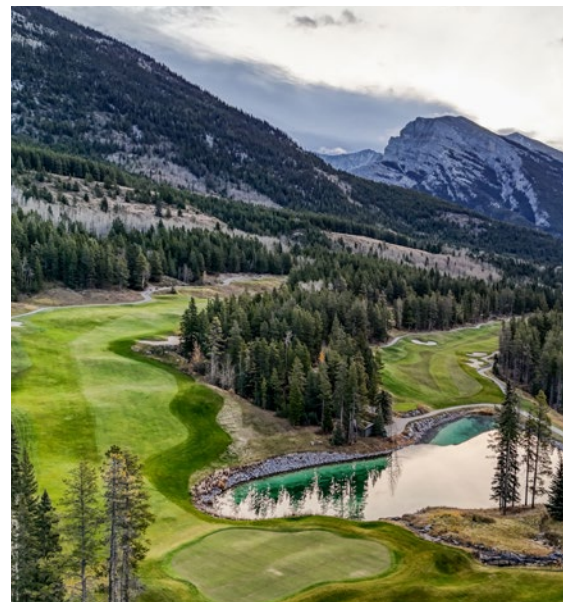
Like in a scramble, all members of a team (usually 4) tee off, and the best ball of the 4 tee shots is selected. All players move their balls to the spot of the best ball. From this point, the hole is played out at stroke play, with all members of the team playing their own ball into the hole.

Shambles should be played with full handicaps to make sure less experienced players contribute to the team's score. Scoring, as with scrambles, can be done any number of ways, such as using one low ball per hole as the team's score, or using two or three low balls per hole. Scoring method used in the shamble is determined by the tournament organizer.

Best Ball

SKILL LEVEL: **INTERMEDIATE** | GAME LENGTH: **5 TO 8 HOURS** | PLAYERS: **2-4**

In a best ball tournament, all team members play their own balls on each hole. At the completion of the hole, the lowest score among all team members serves as the team's score.



Hole Competitions

The backdrop on our 18th hole is the perfect setting for a post tournament \$1 million dollar shootout!

Enhance your golf event at Silvertip with a range of exciting hole competitions. Smaller events can arrange competitions like Closest to the Pin, Long Drive, and Longest Putt, while larger events may wish to add many others such as Hole in One prizing or a Putting Contest. Our Golf Events Team is happy to arrange these hole competitions. Below are a number of hole locations for various contests.

Longest Drive

Longest drive from the tee box on a selected hole — typically a straight Par 5 hole. A proximity marker is placed on the fairway next to the ball of the player with the longest drive. As players surpass the marker of the longest drive, the marker is moved and their name is added to the list. The winner will be determined by the player with the longest drive.

Closest To The Pin (KP)

This contest takes place on a Par 3 hole and the tee shot landing closest to the pin wins! Often tournament planners will have one on-course contest for the front nine and back nine.

Longest Putt

Longest Putt from on the green can be added to any one of the 18 holes. Much like a long drive this involves a proximity marker which is placed from the point of the longest putt with the player's name written on it. If the longest putt is beat by another player, they would then move the marker and write their name on the list.

Putting Contest

A putting contest can be held before, during, or after the tournament. This contest can serve as an additional fundraiser by charging golfers for each attempt to sink a putt from a certain distance. Insurance can be purchased for a minimal amount per golfer providing a grand prize of up to whatever the insurance company is willing to cover.

Hole In One

Most difficult contest, however it is the most rewarding if won. Hole in One insurance is attainable through our tournament coordinator or through a third-party insurer. Most often Hole in One contests will require a spotter provided to witness the Hole in One.

Tournament Planning Timeline

9-12 MONTHS OUT

- Define event objectives (client appreciation, fundraising, social)
- Establish budget parameters
- Coordinate with your Silvertip Event Manager for event planning
- Book optional pre/post indoor venues at Silvertip
- Review Silvertip catering menus if desired
- Estimate participant numbers
- Negotiate and finalize contracts with Silvertip Resort
- Start sponsor acquisition
- Discuss tournament format, special contests, and schedule
- Design event logo and promotional materials

2-3 MONTHS OUT

- Finalize tournament playing format
- Review the status of awards and gifts
- Create initial player pairings
- Develop a tournament rules sheet
- Confirm tee times
- Wrap up sponsor contracts
- Order food and beverage from the Meeting, Event and Tournament Menu

TOURNAMENT DAY

- Arrive at least three hours before golfers
- Set up registration tables near carts or the main walkway
- Ensure cart amenities are in order
- Check special event holes for proximity markers
- Coordinate volunteer activities; hold the pre-event meeting
- Anticipate any last-minute changes or cancellations
- Maintain open communication with PGA Pro and your Silvertip Event Manager
- Don't forget to have fun, after all it is better than being at work!

4 MONTHS OUT

- Finalize event schedule
- Purchase Hole in One insurance if required
- Secure prizes, awards, signage, player kits, and sponsor gifts

1-4 WEEKS OUT

- Finalize pairings and cart assignments
- Provide player numbers to Silvertip
- Conduct inventory of gifts and prizes
- Arrange final logistics with your Silvertip Event Manager
- Prepare scorecards, locker labels, and gift bags

Sponsorship Ideas

Maximize the impact and success of your golf tournament by implementing a variety of sponsorship opportunities. With strategic planning and effective execution, sponsorship initiatives can elevate your event — benefitting both sponsors and participants alike.

Golfer Gifts

Branding golfer gifts for the tournament will create an opportunity for a sponsor to get noticed. Choose a sponsor-branded item that players will take home and use after the event. Some great gifts might include golf apparel, towels, gloves, drinkware, or even a kit filled with golf goodies.

Beverage Hole

Sponsors can add a golf tee box fully-stocked with drinks, ice and snacks to offer to players during the tournament.

Golf Carts

Adding signage to every cart is a great way to get a lot of people to focus on a business name for four hours.

Practice Greens

Every golfer passes it at least twice during the day. A sponsor can have one-on-one interaction allowing golfers to play a quick putting game while positively representing the sponsor's brand.

Silent Auction

Gather popular items that will attract interest and active bidding. Golf lessons, a new set of irons, restaurant gift certificates, weekend getaways, spa services, and art are all great options. Promote the auction in event marketing materials. On the day of the event, showcase auction items enticing attendees with the opportunity to bid and win.

Hole Sponsors

Have a sponsor pay for exclusive signage on one of the 18 holes and also have signage placed at the entrance to the venue.

Mulligan Sponsorship

Golfers can purchase mulligans for “do-over” shots. Golfers can buy three mulligans for a set price each. The sale of mulligans is sometimes used as an additional fundraiser at charitable events.
