There are significant changes being made to these holes to improve the playability and we will be installing drainage, new irrigation, resurfacing, and then sodding these holes in the spring. We need someone who is motivated, a self-starter, and who takes a lot of pride in their work. You will be passionate about working on the golf course and for the jobs being completed.
